

BROWLIFT

The forehead lift, also known as the brow lift, is a surgical procedure that repositions the muscles and tissues in the forehead area that over time have begun to sag and droop. In patients with a high forehead, the incision can be placed at the hairline (trichophytic); otherwise a minimal incision technique using an endoscope can be used. Frown muscles are weakened, but the horizontal forehead lines will remain. Botox may benefit this area.

WHO IS A CANDIDATE?

Those patients who are still in the prime of their lives (between the ages of 40-60) and want to look as young as they feel inside are ideal candidates for browlift surgery. Of course, as with any surgery, people who are physically and mentally healthy will go through surgery easier and experience fewer complications. Be sure to discuss with Dr. Maloney all of your surgical expectations so he can determine if what you desire can be realistically achieved.

WHAT DOES DR. MALONEY NEED TO KNOW ABOUT ME?

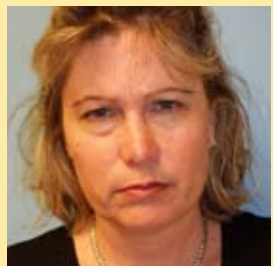

BEFORE SURGERY

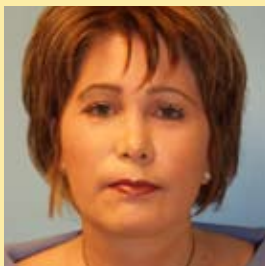

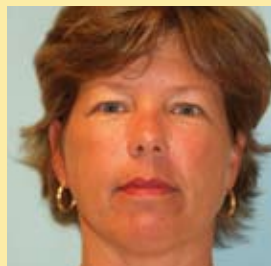
The results of a browlift usually last a lifetime. After a full and quick recovery, you will look in the mirror and see an energetic, bright smiling younger looking you!

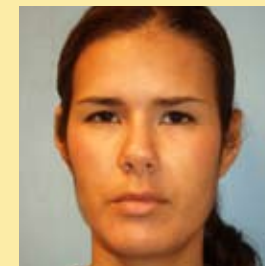

AFTER THE PROCEDURE

After surgery you may experience numbness around the forehead. This is temporary. This numbness could last up to six months. You may have discomfort where the incisions were made, but we will prescribe medicine to control this. Your eyelid area may be swollen and bruised temporarily, but can be easily concealed with makeup. Most are back on their feet and working within 7-10 days and exercising regularly after a month. As with any surgery, there are potential risks associated with this procedure. These risks are normally minor and rarely occur. They range from bleeding and infection to a loss of feeling. With trichophytic browlift scarring is inevitable but is easily concealed in the hairline. In very rare cases, there may be nerve damage and additional surgery may be required to remedy this. You can reduce your chances of complications by following Dr. Maloney's instructions.
