HOW LONG IS THE PROCEDURE?

The procedure typically takes 30 minutes, depending on the areas treated and based on the depth and type of wrinkle or scar. One or more passes with the laser may be required, depending on the degree of sun damage.

IS IT RIGHT FOR MY SKIN?

Skin pigmentation, age, medical history and desired results are all factors that Dr. Maloney will consider to determine if laser skin resurfacing is right for you. To design an appropriate laser treatment for you, we need to know your history of dermabrasion treatment, prior chemical peels, existing viral infections, use of Acutane and any problems with your skin healing.

WHEN WILL I BE ABLE TO GO OUT IN THE SUN?

Avoiding sun exposure will lessen your chances of pigmentation problems during the healing process. Daily use of sunscreen is recommended to help avoid damaging ultraviolet rays. It is best to avoid the sun for several months following your procedure and to continue a daily regimen of sunscreen even after the healing process is complete.

To maintain the beautiful smooth complexion, Dr. Maloney recommends using a skin care program that is customized for your skin. Since sun exposure accelerates the aging of the skin, daily use of sunscreen is essential to maintaining the new youthful complexion.

HOW WILL MY SKIN LOOK AFTERWARDS?

Patients are often amazed by how smooth the skin looks immediately after the procedure. The skin is red initially and generally fades over several weeks. Patients usually return to their activities after 10-14 days.

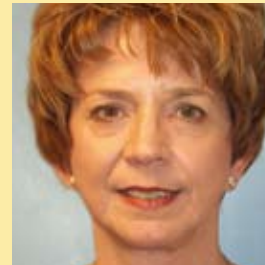

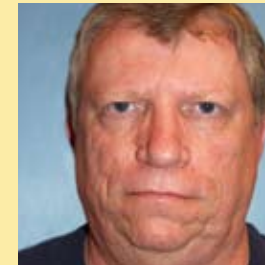
